**AMERICAN LEGION BUCKEYE BOYS STATE PROGRAM CHANGE**

The American Legion Buckeye Boys State program wishes to advise all of the High Schools in Ohio that Buckeye Boys State has been reduced from nine (9) days to eight (8) days in length, with Boys State now starting on Sunday, rather than Saturday.

The American Legion Buckeye Boys State program NO LONGER will conflict with the June ACT test.

A young man can now take the June ACT test without rushing to get to Boys State at the end of the ACT test; being late to the Boys State program; or worse case scenario, opting not to attend Boys State at all.

With the Sunday start of Boys State, a young man now has down time to relax on Saturday after the ACT test, get a good nights' rest and then be 100% ready to attend Buckeye Boys State on Sunday.

This direction should help the Boys State program and sponsoring Posts/Squadrons reduce the number of "No Show's" experienced by the program.
