# American Legion Buckeye Boys State

A Week to Shape a Lifetime

Dear Buckeye Boys State Delegate:

Attendance at American Legion Buckeye Boys State could qualify you for a chance at a \$10,000 or \$5,000 scholarship!

If you are a DIRECT descendant (i.e. child, grandchild, great-grandchild) of a United States veteran who served honorably during World War I, World War II, Korea, Vietnam, Lebanon, Grenada, Panama, the Persian Gulf War, or the war in Afghanistan, or a legally adopted child of a U.S. veteran who served as shown, you are eligible to apply for the "Samsung American Legion Scholarship".

A partnership of the Samsung Electronics Group and the American Legion National Headquarters, each Boys State program of The American Legion and Girls State program of The American Legion Auxiliary will select one (1) candidate to go into a national pool of 98 candidates from the Boys State and Girls State programs across the nation.

From this national pool of 98 candidates, ten (10) national finalists will be selected with each national finalist receiving a \$10,000 Samsung American Legion Scholarship.

In addition, ten (10) National Runners up will be selected with each National runner up receiving a \$5,000 Samsung American Legion Scholarship.

An official online application must be completed by Boys State delegates interested in applying for the Samsung American Legion Scholarship.

As part of the online application, you must scan and upload the Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (DD Form 214) or other government document showing time served on active duty for the veteran on whom you are basing your eligibility.
